A 14-week internship program for NYC young adults (16-24) not working and not in school

Are you looking for a job opportunity?

YAIP will provide you with work experience and training in your field of interest!

Earn up to \$2,500 in 14 weeks!

You could gain permanent employment with a good job evaluation.

As a YAIP intern you will receive:

- 3 weeks of orientation prior to the internship
- 11 weeks of paid internship (20 work hours and 5 workshop hours per week at \$7.25/ hour)
- Job counseling
- Work readiness training

After completing your internship you'll be able to:

- Prepare for college admission
- Enter an occupational skills training program
- Earn a GED Diploma
- Connect with other job and educational opportunities

Selection Process

YAIP is part of a national study whose purpose is to understand how the program helps young people achieve professional and educational goals.

- If you are interested in participating in YAIP, you will be screened to determine your eligibility. You must sign a consent form agreeing to be part of the evaluation and study. However, this does not guarantee acceptance to the program.
- Eligible applicants will then be submitted into a lottery from which program participants will be randomly selected.
- If you are not offered a spot in YAIP, you will be given a list of other programs and services in your community.
- If you are not offered a spot in YAIP, you cannot apply for YAIP for the next 18 months.






