



Prehospital Care EMT Certificate Program

This EMT Basic Certificate Program with defibrillation trains individuals in Prehospital Emergency Care. The program is conducted under the auspices of the Division of Adult and Continuing Education.

A pretest and interview are given to determine eligibility. Clinical rotations are arranged. The awarding of the EMT-B Certificate by New York State for successful completion fulfills the EMT eligibility requirement for LaGuardia's Paramedic Degree Program.

Emergency Medical Technician Basic

Prepare yourself with the knowledge and skills needed to render patient care on an emergency ambulance. When you successfully complete the course, you will take your NYS Department of Health Certification Exam for EMT-Basic. This is a 4-month course and is necessary to advance to the one year program of paramedic education.
