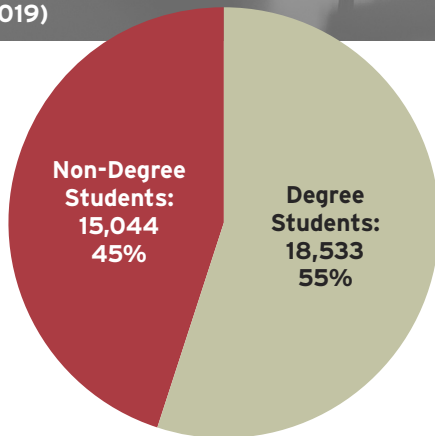
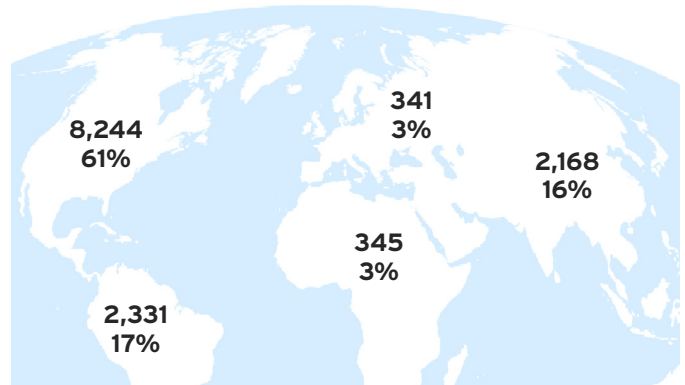


- Over 33,000 students from 150 countries come to LaGuardia Community College each year.
- Established in 1971, LaGuardia has the largest English as a Second Language (ESL) program in New York City.
- Lifetime earnings increase more than \$400,000 for students with an associate degree.
- LaGuardia ranked #5 among U.S. two-year colleges in economic mobility - moving low-income people to the middle class and beyond - in a Stanford University study.
- LaGuardia students are 45% more likely to transfer to a 4-year college than community college students nationally.
- Over the past decade, the LaGuardia Community College Foundation has raised more than \$28 million for scholarships, emergency funds and new initiatives aimed at enhancing student success.
- During the past year, LaGuardia's Business Services Programs have helped 2,731 small businesses grow and created 495 jobs.
- LaGuardia is a national voice on behalf of community colleges, and has garnered major support from such leading funders as Goldman Sachs Gives, Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, Robin Hood, Henry Luce Foundation, The Carroll and Milton Petrie Foundation, and The Teagle Foundation.

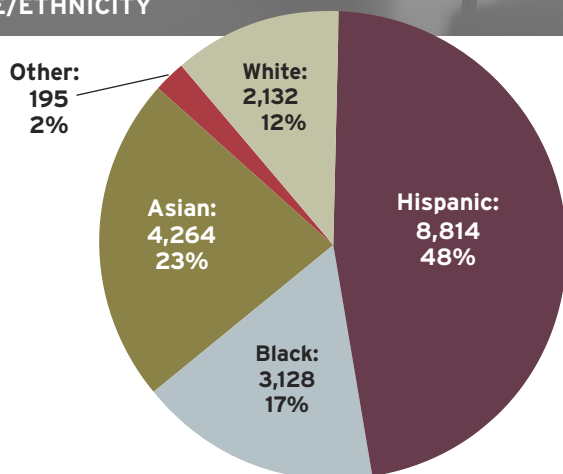

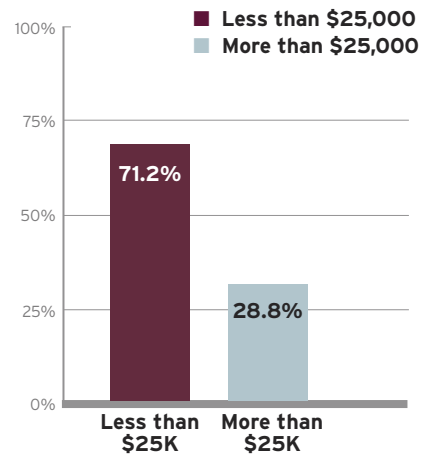
WHERE DO OUR STUDENTS COME FROM?



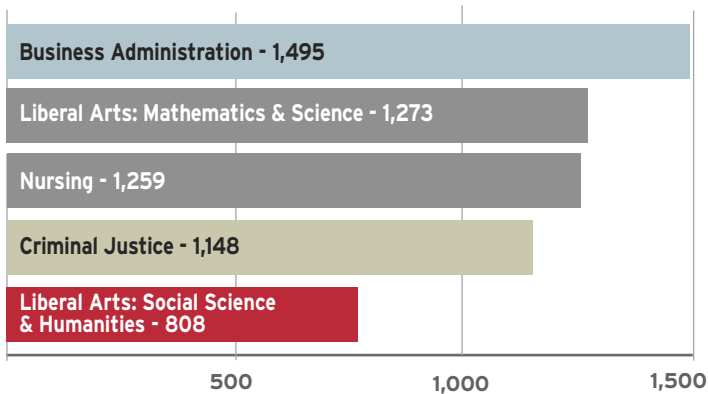
RACE/ETHNICITY



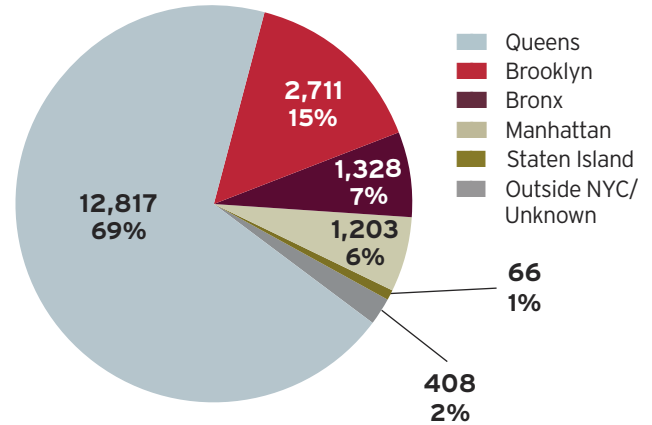
FAMILY INCOME
