The New York City Louis Stokes Alliance for Minority Participation (NYC-LASMP) an alliance of 16 CUNY Colleges and the CUNY Graduate Center which focuses on Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM). The Program is a federally funded research and training program that is sponsored by a grant from the National Science Foundation (NSF). The overall goal of the LSAMP Program is to ensure that a greater number of minority students graduate and pursue careers in STEM fields. The Program also aims to promote a lasting change in how STEM disciplines are viewed by the minority culture of the participating institutions.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Ethnic group: African American, Alaskan Native, American Indian, Hispanic or Pacific Islander
- ✓ Full time student (taking 12 or more credits) at a CUNY campus
- ✓ Majoring in a STEM related discipline
- ✓ GPA of 2.8 or higher
- ✓ US Citizen or Permanent Resident

PROGRAM BENEFITS

- ✓ Financial support *up to* \$5000 per semester for undergraduates
- ✓ Work with research scientists in laboratories
- ✓ Faculty mentoring
- ✓ Academic support through tutorials and workshops
- ✓ Opportunities for summer research, attendance and presentations at local, regional and national conferences, and publishing of research results
