Dear Prospective Nursing Student,

This letter is to inform you that the Nursing Program at LaGuardia Community College has modified the admission requirements for the ATI-TEAS V entrance exam for the Registered Nurse Program that will begin in Spring II 2015. Anyone applying for candidacy in Fall 2015, must adhere to the new guidelines.

Present requirement: Students considering the RN Program or the LPN to RN Advanced Standing Pathway will be required to achieve a *Proficient* level score (58.7-77.3%) on the TEAS V exam.

Modification: A minimum score of 41.3% (Basic level score) will be required on each of the four (4) sections of the TEAS V exam (English, Reading, Science and Math), with an overall score of at 58.7%.

The TEAS V will continue to be offered in the Fall II and Spring II semesters. Students will still be required to take the TEAS V and achieve the required score **before** they apply for candidacy. Students will be permitted 2 attempts at the TEAS to meet the required score. Students who do not meet the required score will need to re-schedule for the next six week semester.
