	Plot courses in the order that you would advise your students to take, where possible.
	For a more complete map, select and integrate Required Common Core courses into your curriculum map. As appropriate to your major, your map should include courses for "STEM Majors" or NON-STEM majors, but not both.
	If your major uses a First Year Seminar (FYS), you can integrate the FYS into your map as an assessment baseline.
	List the program Capstone course to the far right of the curriculum map. Place the Capstone course at a 45+ credit location and address at least one Competency and Ability in that course. Ideally, this course should be taken by your students who have at least 45 credits and are almost graduating.
	When maps have integrated the Required Common Core, <u>every</u> Competency/Ability should be addressed, <u>at least three times</u> across the curriculum. Programs are welcome to add additional deposit points in order to achieve a more fine-grained assessment for their PPRs.
