## 1. Middle States Review

### 2. CUNY Capital Projects

S. Erfan spoke about the CUNY Capital Projects and distributed handouts with the list of proposed capital projects and the 2016-17 capital budget requests.

#### 3. Succession Planning

The Executive Council discussed and reviewed the issue of succession planning for LaGuardia's leadership team. Discussed what what types of training and experiences would foster campus-wide leadership development. Indicated that this will be a major priority for the incoming Director of Human Resources

#### 4. New York City Budget

S. Erfan discussed the Mayor's 2015-16 Budget which will be reviewed and modified by the City Council. This year \$265 million dollars was allocated to CUNY for CUNY-wide construction. Anticipate that we will know LaGuardia's funding allocation in August.

#### 5. LaGuardia and University Issues

The Executive Council discussed the issue of providing merit increases for PSC and Classified staff. They would like further information on the criteria and guidelines in regards to providing increases.

P. Arcario proposed convening a meeting with other community college Provosts and Presidents in regards to improving the process of students transferring from community colleges to the four-year colleges.
