To complete your admissions application for the upcoming semester and Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) application, it is very important that you come prepared with the required documents listed below.

APPLY TO LAGUARDIA

Admissions Application Documents

- **FRESHMAN STUDENT- High school diploma and official high school transcript** OR GED diploma and scores - Original and one photocopy.

TRANSFER STUDENT– Post-secondary transcripts

- Original and one photocopy.

Any student who has previously attended college, business, trade, technical or vocational school, after high school, must apply as a transfer student.

If documents are in a language other than English, a certified translation in English must be provided together with the original language records.

- **A money order for \$65.00 (Freshman student); \$70.00 (Transfer student)** payable to UAPC. *We do not accept credit/debit cards, personal checks or cash.*
- If you are an Alien Registration Card holder or Naturalized Citizen, please bring one photocopy of those documents.

GET MONEY TO PAY

Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Application documents

- **Before your appointment, please be sure to create your Federal Student Aid (FSA ID) at <https://fsaid.ed.gov/>.** All applicants must use a FSA ID to apply for financial aid.
- Bring your student & parent's 2015 Federal Income Tax Returns (1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, W-2, and other records of money earned).
- Records of untaxed income (Social Security benefits, food stamps (SNAP), etc., if applicable).
- Valid email address.
