Guideline for Exposure Control

In case of *Exposure to Blood

- Immediately clean exposed area with soap and water or disinfectant
- Report to your supervisor and Environmental Health and Safety (EHS) Office at (718) 482 5507

In Case of Blood Spill Unrelated to a Medical Emergency

- Do not attempt to clean up. Isolate the area of the spill.
- Call Public Safety at (718) 482 5555 and or Housekeeping at (718) 482 5550

Contaminated Items/Equipment

- Ensure housekeeping collects all contaminated disposable material
- Non-disposable items must be disinfected by housekeeping prior to reuse
- All contaminated sharps and Syringes must be collected in a puncture resistant container
- Store these items in a secure location until EHS arrange a pick up.
- Sharps collection containers are also located near the Security Post at the main entrance of each building (E, M, B, and C)

* An **exposure** is any contact with another person's blood or any bodily fluid containing blood that enters your body through:

- Mucous membranes: eyes, mouth, nose
- Non-intact skin
- Lacerations/cuts
