Below are some important highlights to note from the above referenced links:

- A waiver petition is no longer required for contiguous state travel (CT, MA, PA, NJ, and VT), travel to CDC's states
 with "low" or "moderate" levels of transmission or travel to countries listed by the Department of State as level
 1 or 2. However, an "Intent to Travel" (pre-screening) is required for the above mentioned states, countries and
 contiguous states.
- Petitions where petitioners have full vaccination verified in a CUNY system (CUNYFirst or RF Portal) will be fully reviewed at the campus.
 - o Consult with your campus' Location Vaccine Authority liaisons for any vaccination inquiries.
- Petitions where one or more petitioner(s) do not have full vaccination verified in a CUNY system, if supported by the Provost, must be forwarded to Central Office for review.
 - o Consult with your campus' Location Vaccine Authority liaisons for any vaccination inquiries.
