1. Review of the Findings from the Strategic Directions Summit

• Provost Paul Arcario discusses the findings from the Strategic Directions summit that was held on February 1, 2019. He stated that with Rosemary Tallmadge's assistance, 10 pages of notes were grouped into five goals with each goal containing 4-5 objectives. At this moment the working outline is a working draft. There will be a JAM held next week on Friday, March 8th and Saturday, March 9th that will discuss the working outline goals. JAM is opening to all LaGuardia faculty and staff. Provost Arcario has also invited 150 LaGuardia students to participate.

2. Enrollment

• Vice President Seals informed the Executive Council that from January 2, 2019 till February 26, 2019, a glitch was discovered in the enrollment numbers for continuing students. There were 913 FTE's over counted. The last enrollment report showed that LaGuardia was 82% to reach target goal when in reality it is only 75%. Vice President Seals will be having a meeting today at 4:30 pm with Henry Saltiel and IT folks to discuss and identify what could have gone wrong.

3. Divisional Reports
