Meeting Notes

- I. Welcome/Campus Update: President Adams updated on the search for the VP of Adult and Continuing Education (ACE) and Human Resources. He indicated he is meeting with the President's Advisory Council on Diversity, Equity and Inclusion to inform the job announcement for the Senior Director of Inclusion position. He also updated the Cabinet on pending changes being made to enhance fundraising operations. President Adams noted the tragic death of a LaGuardia student and has asked VP Seals to handle appropriate the appropriate steps to take with the family and requested that a written protocol be developed to guide the college's response for future tragedies. President Adams noted the receipt of a \$250,000 donation (\$50,000 in the summer and \$200,000 in recent days) and highlighted that the Foundation's goal for fundraising for the fiscal year is surpassing goals and will ask the Foundation Board to increase their goals for the fiscal year. President Adams urged Cabinet members to attend Diversity Week events.
- II. Review 11/9/20 Cabinet Meeting Notes: Meeting notes were reviewed and no changes identified.

III. Student Enrollment

- a. Weekly Enrollment Dashboard: VP Seals presented the dashboard (attached).
- b. Fall 2 Enrollment Strategies: Deans De Los Santos and Grachan reviewed a comparison between enrollment for Spring 2020 and Spring 2021 as of 11/13/20. They addressed key initiatives being taken to support student enrollment, including improved communications, making it easier for students to schedule appointments and expanded weekend hours.
- c. Update on Student Balances and College Actions: Provost Arcario indicated that a meeting was convened to address the data and research needs that will inform decision-making. The issue will be addressed at the Cabinet meeting on 11/23/20.

V. Increasing Compliance with Mandatory Training for Sexual and Interpersonal Violence Prevention and Response Course (SPARC): President Adams indicated that he requests that all VPs and Deans take the training and encourage managers to promote the training with their staffs.
