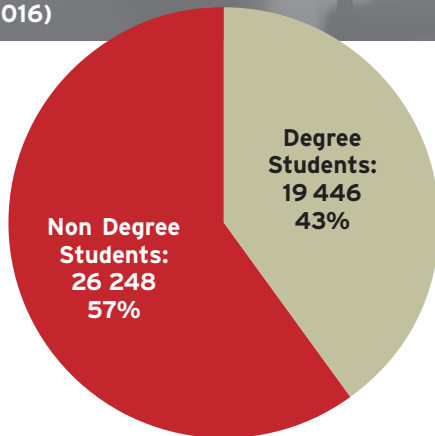
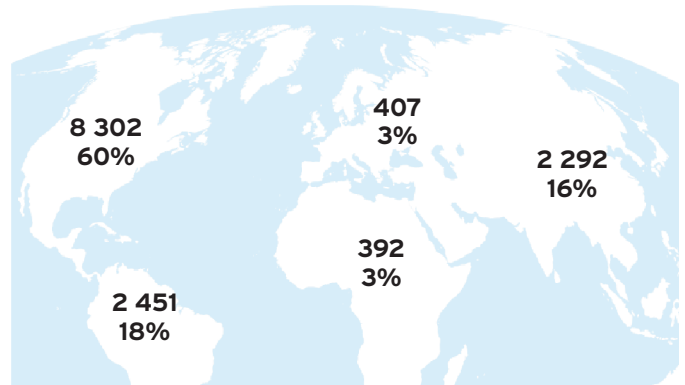


- Over 45,000 students from more than 150 countries come to LaGuardia Community College each year.
- Established in 1971, LaGuardia has the largest English as a Second Language (ESL) program in New York City.
- Lifetime earnings increase more than \$400,000 for students with an associate degree.
- LaGuardia ranked #5 among U.S. two-year colleges in economic mobility - moving low-income people to the middle class and beyond - in a Stanford University study.
- LaGuardia students are 35% more likely to transfer to a 4-year college than community college students nationally.
- Over the past decade, the LaGuardia Community College Foundation has raised more than \$20 million for scholarships, emergency funds and new initiatives aimed at enhancing student success.
- During the past year, LaGuardia's Business Services Programs have helped 2,652 small businesses grow and created 1,847 jobs.
- LaGuardia is a national voice on behalf of community colleges, and has garnered major support from leading foundations such as Goldman Sachs, Bill and Melinda Gates, Robin Hood, Kresge, Ford, Henry Luce, Carroll and Milton Petrie, and Mellon.

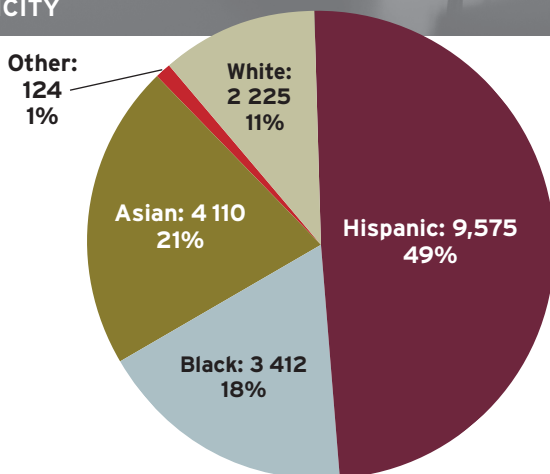

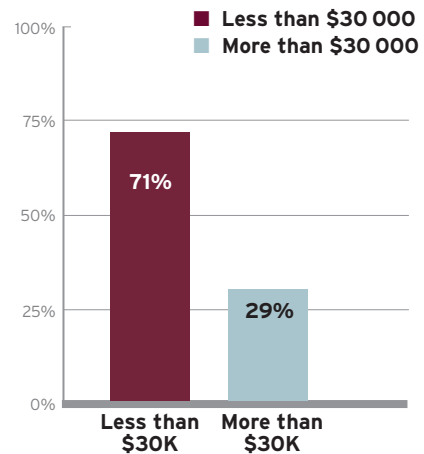
WHERE DO OUR STUDENTS COME FROM?



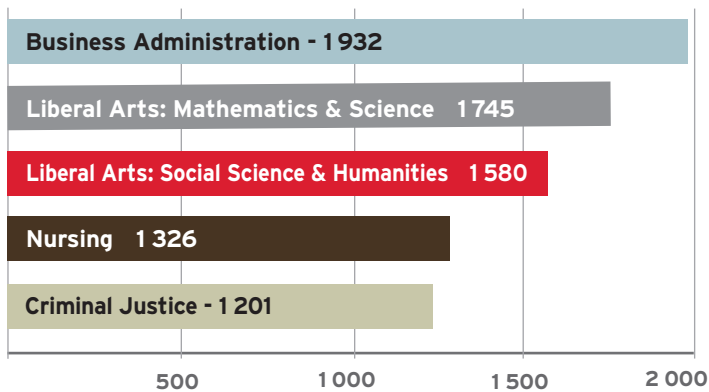
RACE/ETHNICITY



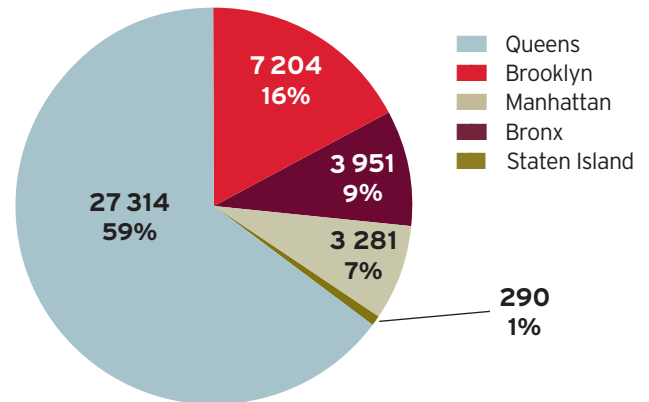
FAMILY INCOME
