## FOR ALEKS STUDENTS ONLY

1. Go to www.aleks.com, $\log$ in, click on "Actions", then on "Switch to a new course and sign up using the following course code: CT3MP-JML4Y
2. Complete the initial assessment on ALEKS.
3. Based on the initial assessment you will be given a list of topics to master. In order to complete the Second Chance Program and to be given an opportunity to retake the CUNY Final Exam you must spend at least 20 hours in ALEKS and achieve a course mastery of at least $70 \%$.
4. During your work in ALEKS you will be given periodic assessments. Please complete them to the best of your knowledge as they influence your course mastery level.
5. Once you have completed the requirements from item 4 , that is, 20 hours spent in ALEKS and at least $70 \%$ course mastery, prof. McCormack will add your name to a list to retake the CUNY Final Exam on Tuesday January $26^{\text {th }}, 2016$ at 10am.
6. If your new CUNY Final Exam score is at least $60 \%$, you will be given a passing grade for MAT096.

## FOR EDUCOSOFT STUDENTS ONLY

1. Login to your Educosoft account
2. Select repeat course
3. Join MAT096( $2^{\text {nd }}$ Chance)
4. Students must complete all assignments on Educosoft, and achieve a grade of at least $\mathbf{7 0 \%}$ on each assignment and spend at least 20 hours working in Educosoft. If both those goals are achieved, then prof. McCormack will add your name to the list to retake the CUNY Final Exam.
5. If your new CUNY Final Exam score is at least $60 \%$, you will be given a passing grade for MAT096.
