SCHOLARSHIPS

WORK STUDY

The Federal Work Study (FWS) Program offers students an opportunity to earn money by working part time on or off campus.

You can apply for FWS through your FAFSA application.



JOB SEARCH

The Center for Career and Professional Development helps you plan your professional path and obtain employment.

Getting a job can help fund your education plus build your resume while in school.



FEDERAL LOANS

You'll need to pay back the federal government if you decide to take out a loan.

There are two federal loan options you can apply for: subsidized (interest accrues after graduation) or unsubsidized (interest accrues at point of disbursement).
