TO-DO LIST



It can be tough remembering everything you have to do when you start classes. Making a list and checking off your tasks as you go can be very helpful!

MAKE A SCHEDULE



Aim to sign up for 4-6 courses a semester. Spread them out over the week so you have time for studying.

SEE A TUTOR

Tutors can help you understand difficult concepts or provide more in-depth instruction for you to expand your knowledge in a particular subject.



ASK QUESTIONS

If you don't understand the work, make sure to ask your professor or a classmate for help. If you get questions wrong on a test, ask your professor for the answers so you don't get it wrong on the final.



OFFICE HOURS

Visit your professor during office hours to help build a stronger relationship. While you're there get help with your homework, and get feedback on projects or essays.



FLASH CARDS

Flash cards help with memorization when you're making and using them.



STUDY GROUPS

Studying with friends helps by sharing notes and discussing classwork.



NOTE TAKING

Take notes during class! If you miss a class, ask your classmates for their notes.



PRACTICE TESTS

Search for tests online or work with your study group to quiz each other.
