Writing Center tutors can help you get started on a research paper, teach you how to proofread, or explain and correct your graded essays.

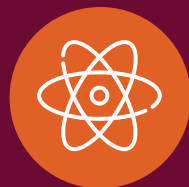


THE MODERN LANGUAGE LAB & TUTORING CENTER
