- Fundraising Organization of LaGuardia Community College
- Provides support exclusively for LaGuardia students
- Privately raised funds from donors we establish relationships with
- Not government funds, so more flexible distribution including international, undocumented and DACA students
- Connecting LaGuardia students to opportunities resulting from the funds raised by The Foundation



Find out if You're Eligible

- To receive a Foundation Scholarship, you must:
- Be a full-time LaGuardia student, regardless of residency status
- Be taking 12 or more credits (or equivalent)
- Be in good academic standing with a 2.0 GPA or above
- Establish a GPA for at least one semester to be eligible
- Be able to demonstrate financial need

International Students

- International Students are not eligible for State or Federal Financial Aid but MAY be eligible for support from the LaGuardia Foundation
- F1 Status are eligible to apply after completing one semester with 12 credits or more. Before submitting a Foundation Scholarship application, F1 students must be approved by the <u>International Student Services</u>. If you are an F1 Student, please email the ISS office at <u>FSInformation@lagcc.cuny.edu</u> for guidelines.



Non F1 Status are eligible to apply. To determine eligibility, resident students should file a <u>FAFSA</u> and non-resident students should complete a <u>Needs Assessment Form</u> and email it separately to <u>foundationscholarship@lagcc.cuny.edu.</u>

ASAP Students

- ASAP students who receive no tuition assistance may apply. ASAP students whose tuition is covered by financial aid or an ASAP tuition waiver are not eligible for Foundation Scholarships
- ASAP Students also receive books and transportation allowances through their program
