## B. ADMISSION AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR SENIOR COLLEGE PROGRAM (e.g., minimum GPA, audition/portfolio):

LaGuardia Community College graduates with the Associate Degree in Therapeutic Recreation will receive 60 credits toward the Bachelor of Science, at Lehman College. Students must have a minimum GPA of a 2.5 and have earned a grade of at least a C (75) in all required program courses at LaGuardia Community College.

Associate of Science Degree Graduates of CUNY Colleges are exempt from all Required Core, Flexible Core, and Foreign Language Component of the General Education requirements. To earn a Bachelor's Degree at Lehman College, CUNY Associate Degree graduates need to:

- complete at minimum 50% of the courses required for the major and minor (if applicable) in residence
- two upper-level LEH interdisciplinary courses chosen under advisement
- two writing intensive courses (may be satisfied as part of LEH requirement) elective courses, if needed.
- 60 liberal arts credits are required for the BS

Determination of the 60 Liberal Arts credits required for the baccalaureate degree in accordance with New York State Education Department requirements will be made by Lehman College.

Total transfer credits granted toward the baccalaureate degree: 60

Total additional credits required at the senior college to complete baccalaureate degree: 60
