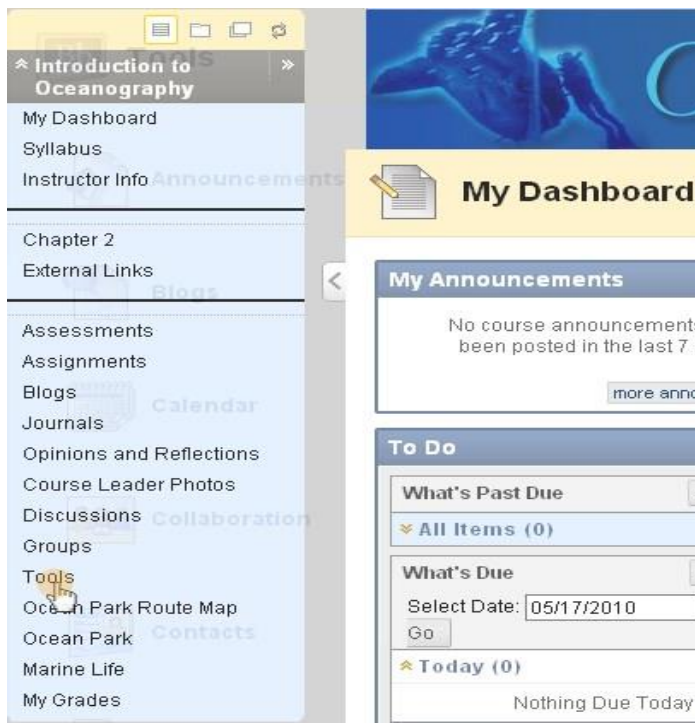

Step 1. Click on **Tools** in the course menu.

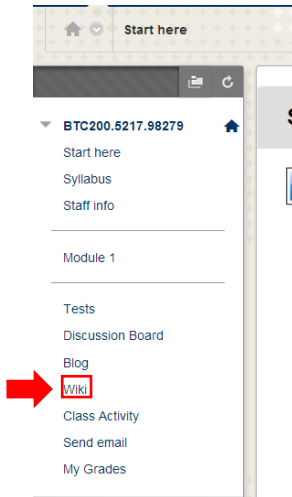

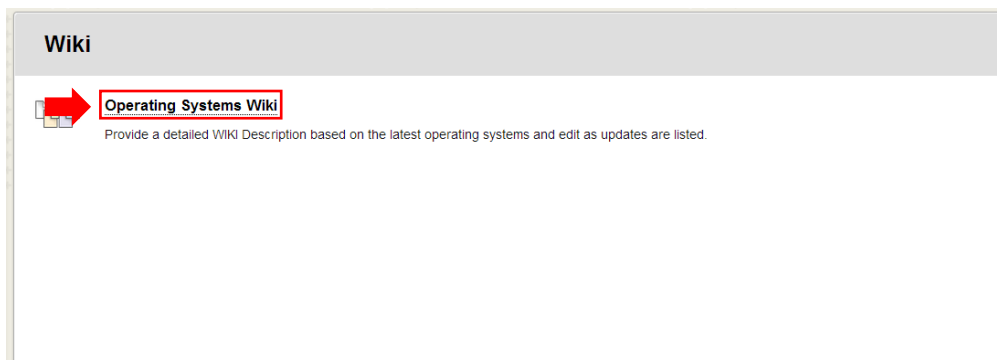


Step 2. Click on Wiki



Step 3. Next select Operating Systems Wiki (Click and Create a Wiki Page if needed)




Step 4. Enter a brief name for the new wiki page.



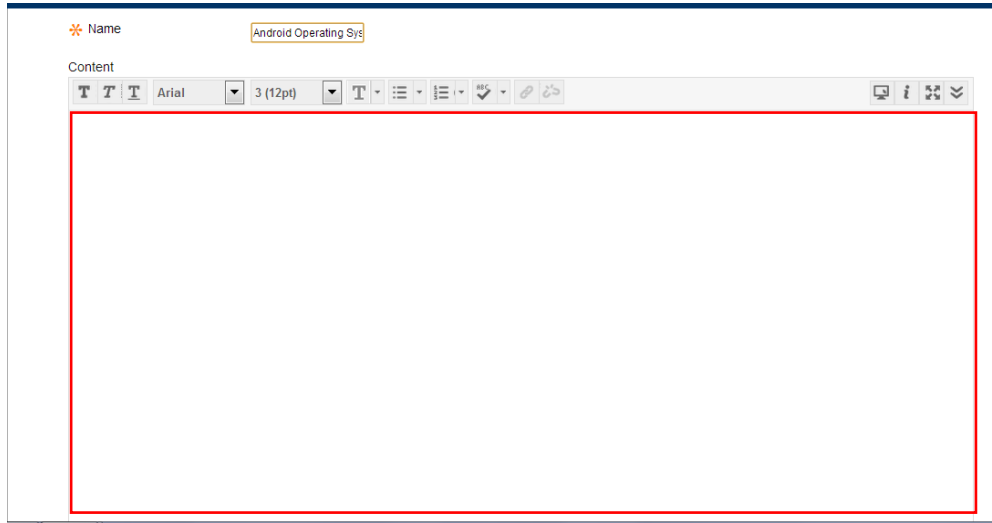

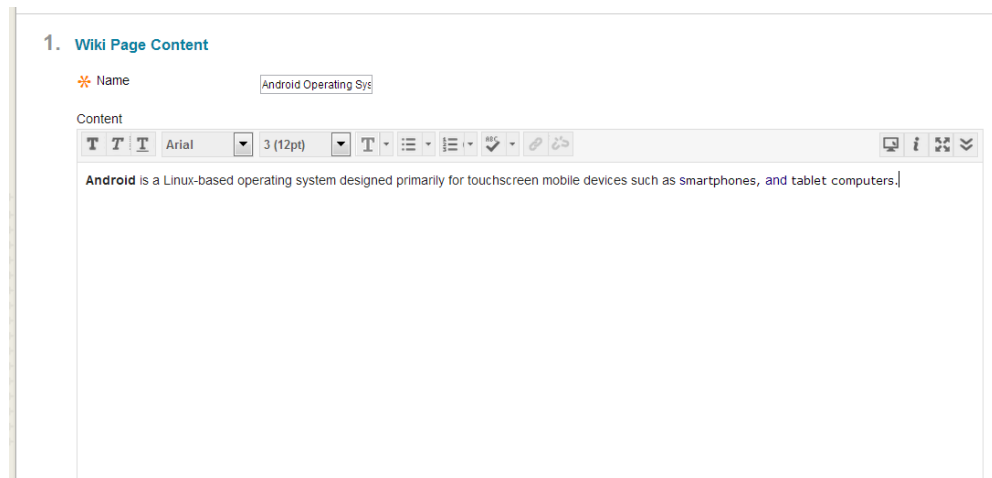

Step 6. Enter your content in the text editor.



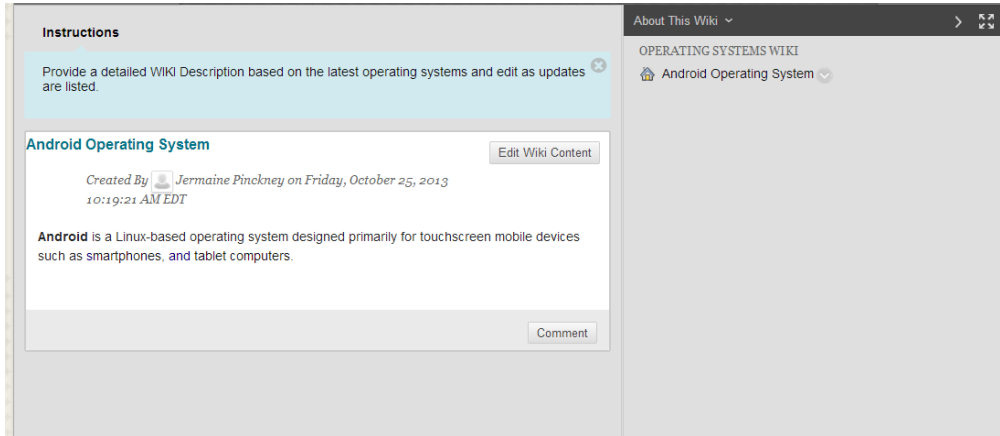
Step 7. Your content should look like the picture shown below.



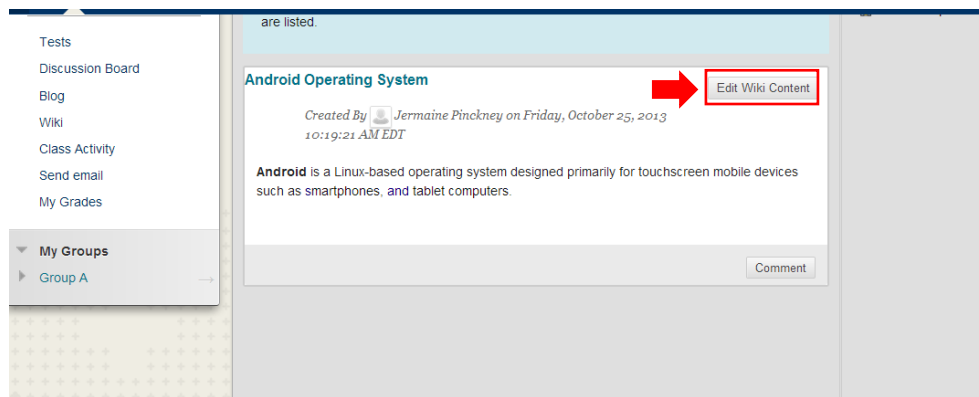
Step 8. Click Submit

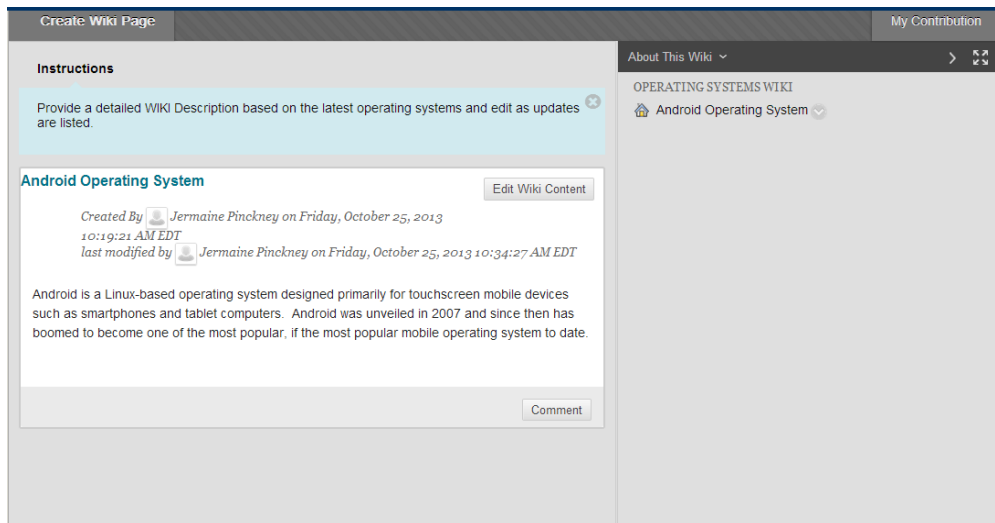

Step 13. Click **Submit**

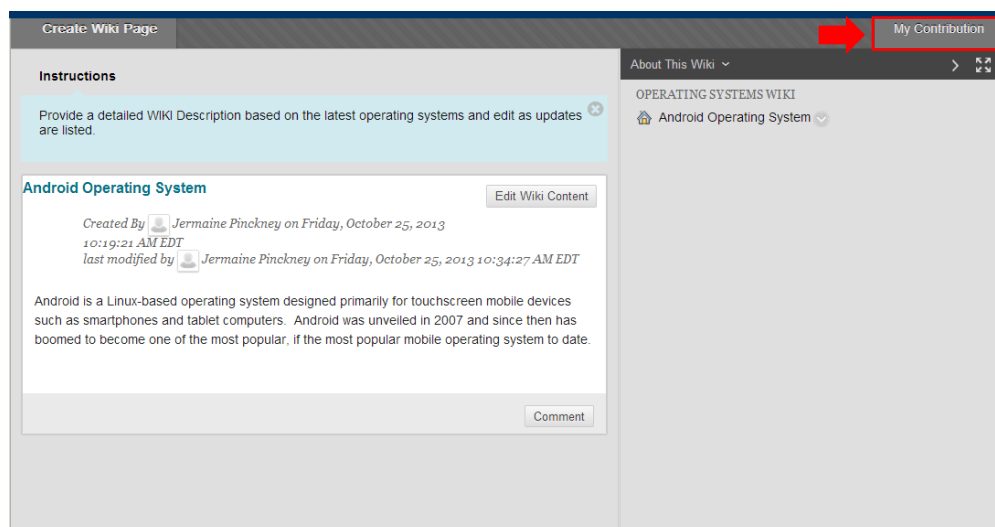
