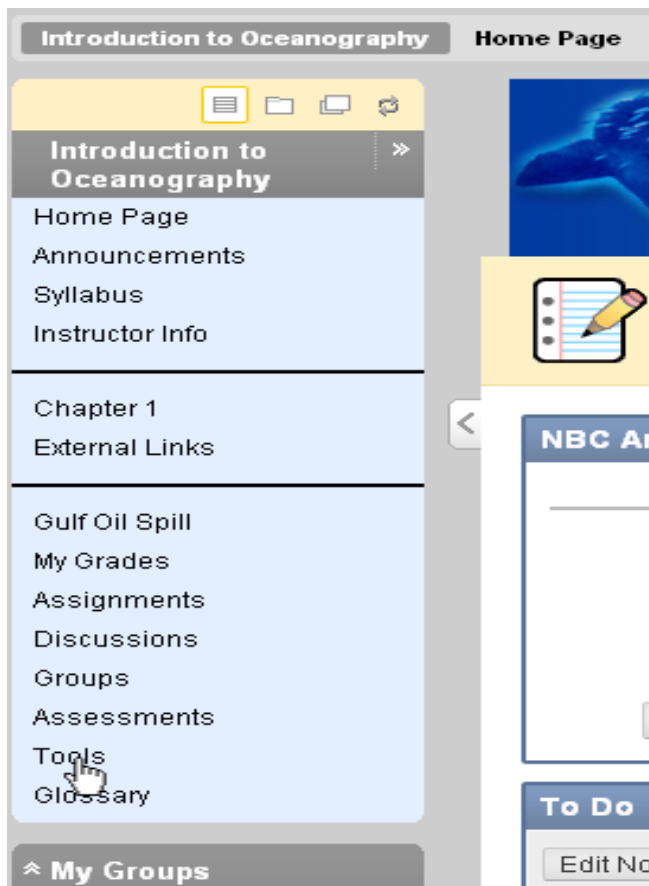

Step 1 – To begin Click on Tools on the course menu.

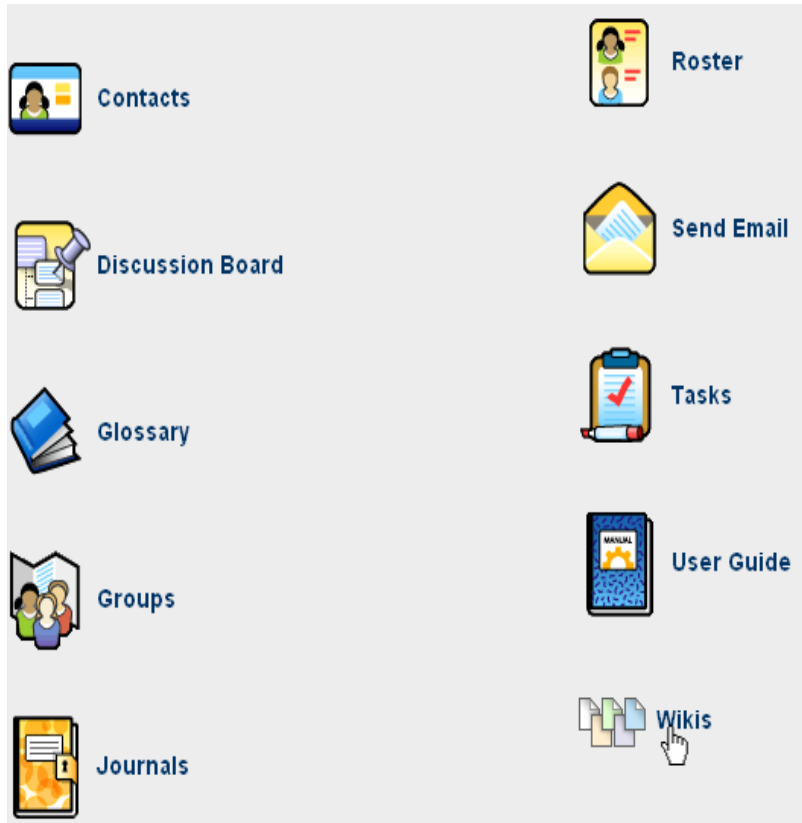

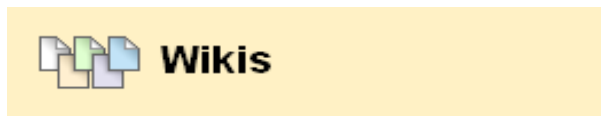

Step 2 – Click Wikis




Step 3 – Select a Wiki, Click on Coral Reef Information.



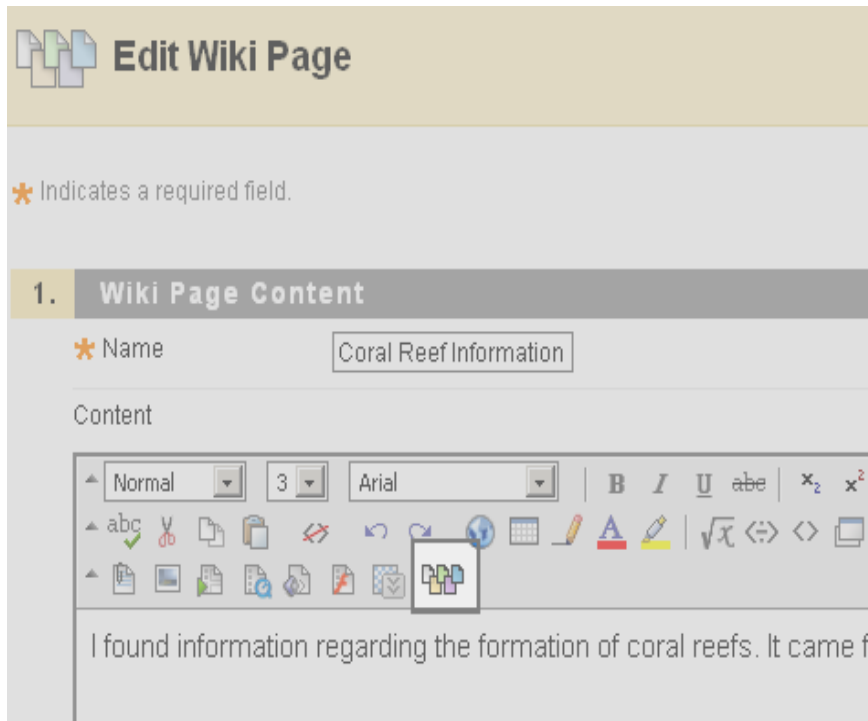

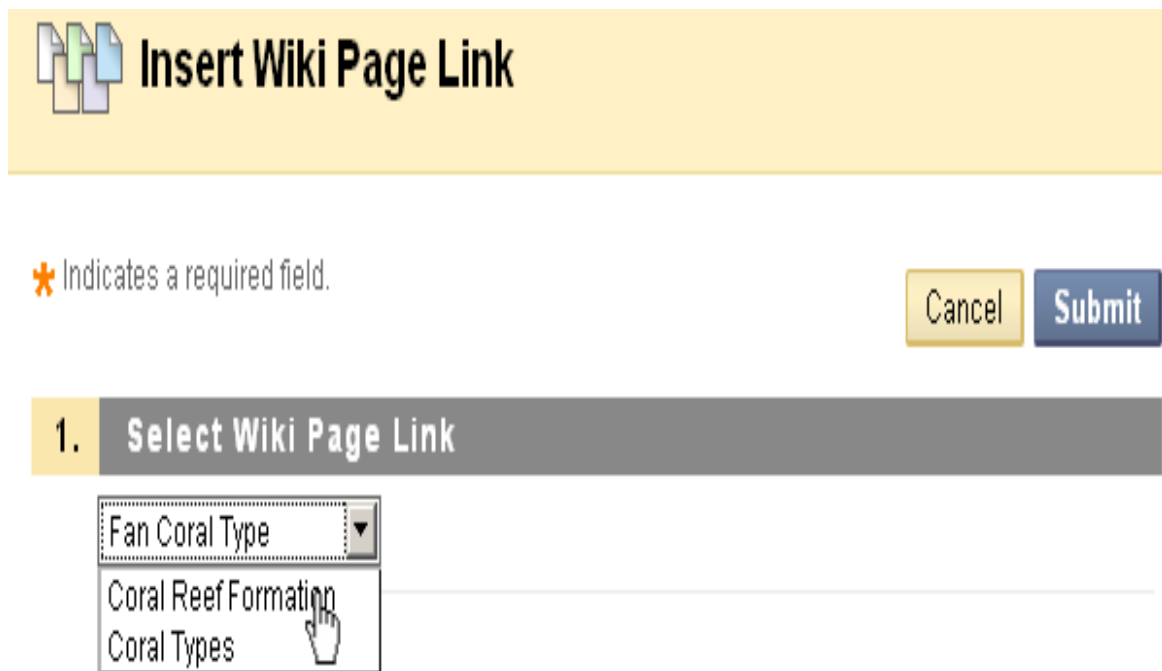

Step 7 – Select the page to link to from the drop down box. Select Coral Reef Formation.




Step 8 – You can use the existing page.

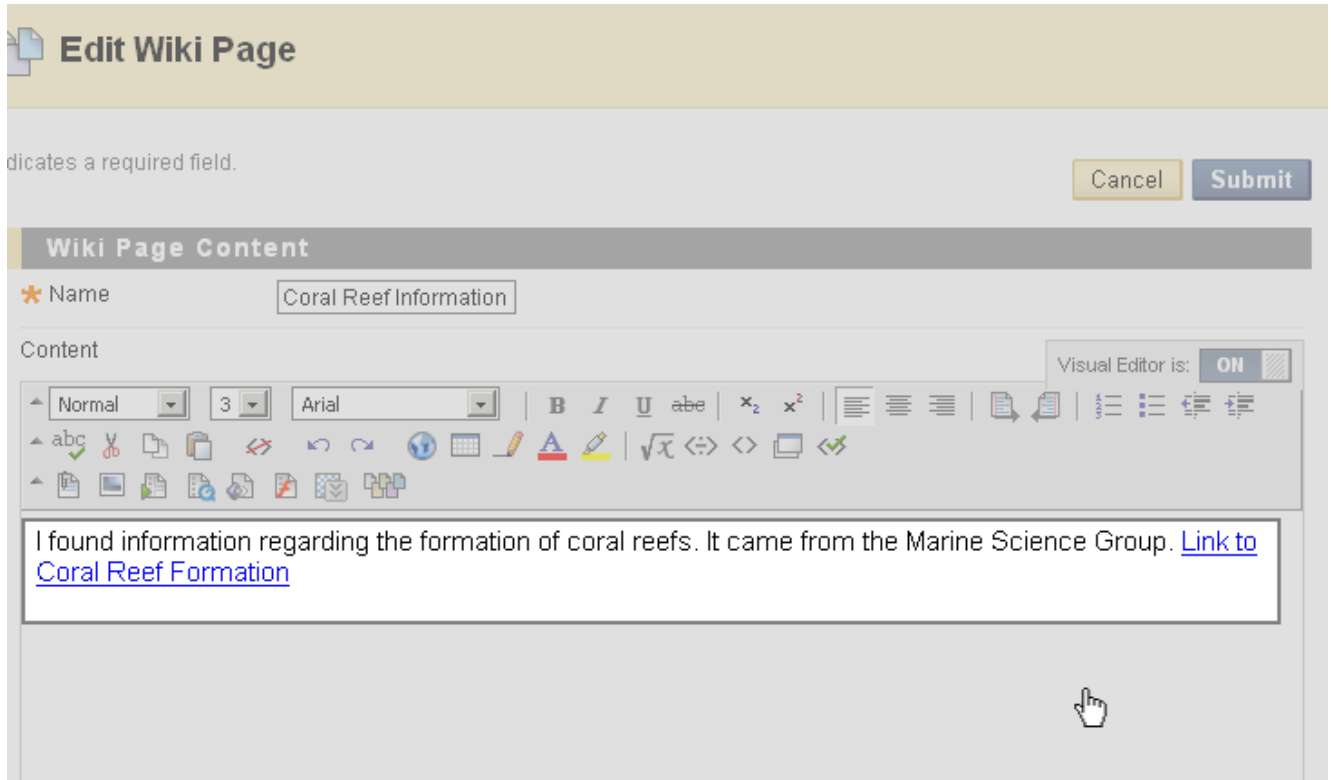

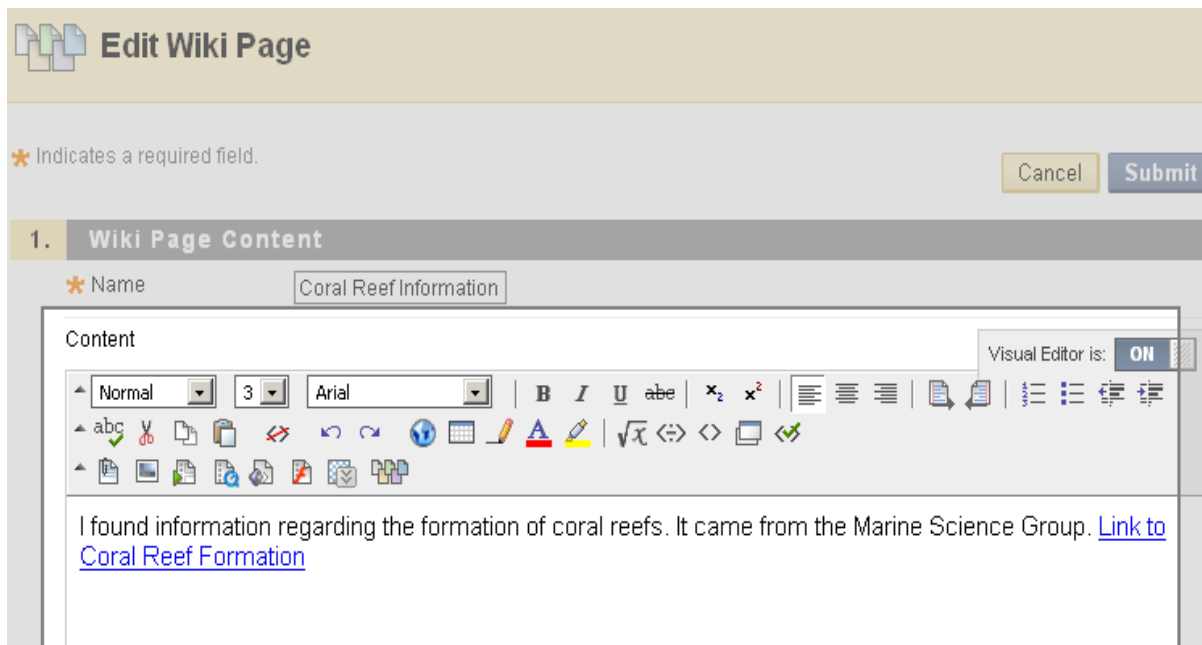


