

Academic Affairs Research/Scholarly Work Award 2017-18

This is a competitive award designed to support the scholarly/creative work of tenure-track faculty in their 6th year of appointment. Proposals will be rated by a committee established by the Provost.

Eligibility: Full-time, tenure-track faculty in their sixth year of appointment.

Award amount: 3 hours released time for one academic year. For this round, the released time will be awarded in the 2017-18 academic year. Note that the award cannot be “rolled over” to next year; you must be scheduled for teaching hours in 2017-18 that you can actually be released from. [The number of awards granted will depend upon the available budget.]

Criteria:

- Submission of scholarly/creative work by August 31, 2018. Priority will be given to faculty currently engaged in preparation of a manuscript or other scholarly or creative work to be submitted - not necessarily accepted - by Aug 31, 2018 for publication or exhibit.
- Scholarly/creative merit of the project.
- Institutional Strengthening.

Your proposal should answer the following questions. Length should be from 300-600 words. Submit your completed application to Provost Paul Arcario by COB, August 31, 2017.

Scholarly/creative merit of the work: What will be the potential contribution to the field?

Institutional Strengthening: What is the potential for the project to strengthen/contribute to the college? In what way (e.g., the curriculum, pedagogy, student success)?
