Baruch College - Transfer Information Guide

Baruch Transfer Profile

Centrally located in the Gramercy Park area of Manhattan, Baruch serves over 16,000 students in more than 110 different programs of study including business, public affairs and a wide range of liberal arts majors.

- \rightarrow The *average** student who transfer to Baruch College achieved a cumulative GPA of 3.30.
- → The *average** student who transfers to Baruch College has completed 67 credits.
- → Maximum credits accepted from associate degree granting institutions is 70 credits
- ightarrow Maximum credits accepted from bachelor degree granting institutions is 93 credits
- ightarrow Transfer students must have a minimum GPA of 2.25 to be considered for admission.

*Not a minimum requirement, students are routinely admitted with GPA's above and below the average GPA.

Admission Requirements

Take the CUNY/ACT Skills Assessment Test and Compass Mathematics placement Test in reading and writing (Transfer students who have completed a three credit college-level English or Math course with a grade of C or better are exempt from the CUNY Reading and Writing exams and/or Math exams.)

CUNY Pathways & General Education Requirements

- → If you have earned an Associates of Arts (AA) or an Associates of Science (AS) you are waived from CUNYs common core and half of their individual college option requirements.
- → If you have earned an Associates of Applied Sciences (AAS) you are waived from Pathways courses that you have already completed at LaGuardia.
- → If you have NOT completed an associates degree, CUNY senior colleges will require you to complete up to 12 credits as part of your college option.

*College option courses at Baruch: ENG 2800 or CMP 2850 AND the 400 level minor capstone

Baruch College - Key Programs and Majors

Zicklin School of Business Major Requirements

In order to be eligible for the Zicklin School of Business, students need to satisfy all of the following criteria:

- Completion of 7 pre-business courses with a minimum 2.25 GPA (Typical GPA for admitted students into Zicklin School of Business is between 3.2 and 3.8).
- Completion of at least 45 credits with an overall Baruch GPA³ of 2.50 or higher
- 1. ACC 2101 Financial Accounting (LaGuardia: BTA 111 and BTA 112)
- 2. CIS 2200 Introduction to Information Systems and Technologies (LaGuardia: BTC 200)
- 3. ECO 1001 Microeconomics (LaGuardia: SSE 103)
- 4. ECO 1002 Macroeconomics (LaGuardia: SSE 104)
- 5. ENG 2100 Introduction to Comp 1 (LaGuardia: ENG 101 or ENC 101)
- 6. LAW 1101 Fundamentals of Business Law (LaGuardia: BTM 110)
- 7. STA 2000 Business Statistics I (LaGuardia: MAT 120 or MAT 119)

NOTE: MATH MAT 200 and MAT 201 Pre-calculus and Calculus is also highly recommended NOTE: If students completed HUC 106 they will be waived from taking COM 2020 at Baruch College

School of Public Affairs Admission Requirements

In order to be eligible for the School of public Affairs, students need to satisfy all of the following criteria:

- Completion of 4 pre-public affairs courses with a minimum cumulative 2.25 GPA
- Completion of at least 45 credits.
- 1. ENG 2150 (LaGuardia: ENG 102)
- 2. STA 2000 Business Statistics I (LaGuardia: MAT 120)
- 3. MTH 2003 or Higher MTH 2003 is not required to declare the SPA major, but it is a pre-requisite to many SPA major courses. (*LaGuardia: MAT 115 and MAT 200*)
- 4. ECO 1001 Eco 1001 is not required to declare the SPA major, but it is a pre-requisite to PAF 3102 (*LaGuardia: SSE 103*)

Weissman School of Arts and Science Admission Requirements

In order to be eligible for the School of public Affairs, students need to satisfy all of the following criteria:

- Minimum cumulative 2.20 GPA
- Completion of two semesters of a foreign—Must be in the same language and at the proper level.
- COM 1010 Speech Communication (LaGuardia: HUC 106)
