

**POSITION:** Faculty Student Disciplinary Committee (student representatives, six available positions)

**POSITION SUMMARY:**

The Faculty Student Disciplinary Committee consists of faculty, staff and students from the college community who are charged with determining whether a student accused of violating the Henderson Rules, school code of conduct, CUNY rule or policy is responsible for the alleged misconduct.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

- Minimum GPA of 2.0

**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Attend a mandatory training provided by the college and/or CUNY on the policies and procedures related to the student conduct process.\*
- Possibly serve on the FSDC subcommittee to hear disciplinary matters related to sexual misconduct (Two out of the six elected students will be selected).
- Listen to testimony and review evidence during a college hearing.
- Collaborate with other FSDC members in making a decision based on the evidence provided.
- Determine a disciplinary sanction, if deemed appropriate by the committee.

\*Committee members will not be able to serve in any capacity without attending the mandatory training.
