## Pre/Co-requisites

Refer to the Pre- and Co-requisite list below to ensure you register for the appropriate courses.

Pre-requisite: A course which must be completed prior to taking another course

Co-requisite: A course which must be taken during the same session as another course.

1. ENG101 PRE: ENG99 or English Proficiency
2. SCB203 PRE: ENG99 or English Proficiency and MAT99 or Math Proficiency
3. SSY101 PRE: ENG99 or English Proficiency and MAT99 or Math Proficiency
4. MAT106 PRE: Math Proficiency

## Other Program Notes

Key courses are used to determine a candidate's eligibility to enter the clinical phase of the program. During the clinical phase, students are trained to be registered nurses. The clinical phase is a two-year sequence in which students must attend full-time.

Key Courses: ENG101 (or ENA/ENC101), SSY101, MAT106, SCB203

Note: although not a key course, students must take SCB204 before entering the clinical phase

## General Information

DEVELOPMENTAL COURSES Based on your incoming proficiency, you may require additional preparation before entering college-level English (ENG101) or Math (MAT107,115,120,etc.). Options can include:

- A) Co-requisite courses such as ENA101, MAT117/119/123
- B) CUNY Start, Math Start, or CLIP
- C) English-as-a-Second-Language (ESL) courses
- D) Developmental courses such as ENA099 or MAT099
- E) First Year Institute Program (FYIP) Workshops

SESSIONS I AND II Each semester, Fall and Spring, has two sessions, Session I (12-weeks) and Session II (6-weeks). It is recommended that you take 15 credits per semester for timely graduation. CREDITS & HOURS Courses often meet for the same number of hours per week as academic credits awarded, but in some cases your classes meet for more hours, listed in the Credits column when applicable.

PRIORITY COURSES Priority Courses are important for your progress and should be taken in the suggested order.

URBAN STUDIES All students must complete an Urban Studies course to graduate. Urban Studies courses have an "N" at the end of the course code (example: HUN192).
