How does the LaGuardia Community College Foundation help students?

Fundraising organization of LaGuardia Community College

Provides support exclusively for LaGuardia students from donors: individuals, corporations, and foundations

Support in the form of scholarships, emergency aid, on-campus payroll support, and stipends from programs like the President's Society

Not government funds, so more flexible and can help international, undocumented and DACA students

Am I eligible for a LaGuardia Scholarship? Do I need to apply and how?

To receive a Foundation Scholarship, you must:



Be a full-time LaGuardia student (taking 12 or more credits or equivalent)



Be of any residency status



Be in good academic standing



Students with GPA of 2.0 to 4.0 may be reviewed for a general scholarship award upon enrollment, if eligible (submission of a scholarship application is no longer required for **General scholarships.**)



Students with GPA of 3.0 and above are encouraged to submit a scholarship application. An interview may be required for **Named scholarships.**

I'm an International Student. Am I Eligible?

International Students are not eligible for State or Federal Financial Aid but **MAY** be eligible for support from the LaGuardia Foundation.

Program Info and Eligibility:

- FI Status are eligible to apply after completing one semester with 12 credits or more. Before submitting a Foundation Scholarship application, FI students must be approved by the **International Student Services**. If you are an FI Student, please email the ISS office at **FSInformation@lagcc.cuny.edu** for guidelines.
- Non FI Status are eligible to apply. To determine eligibility, resident students should file a **FAFSA** and non-resident students should complete a **Needs Assessment Form** and email it separately to **foundationscholarship@lagcc.cuny.edu**.



Can I Qualify for Emergency Financial Aid?

- We know that attending college is much more complicated than just paying for tuition.
- To help cover college and living expenses other than tuition, the LaGuardia Foundation may be able to help with Emergency Financial Aid for books, transportation, childcare, housing and food.
