

NURSING PROGRAMS ATI TEAS ENTRANCE EXAM REQUIREMENTS

Students have to **TEST** before the **SPRING 2022**
DEADLINE of JUNE 7TH 2022

Effective **DECEMBER 2020**

TEAS REGISTRATION:

- Students must select **"ATI Remote Proctor – Nursing"** to take a proctor TEAS exam **ONLINE**.
- We will **NOT** accept student's ATI TEAS Exam Results if the exam was taken in-person. This will count against your **2** attempts.
- When prompted with **"Student Number"** please type in your **"LaGuardia EMPLID"**
- **ATI Exam Results** will automatically be sent to LaGuardia's Nursing Programs.
- Students under the major LPN or undeclared Pre-Health/RN will **ONLY** have a total of **2** attempts to take the TEAS.

If you have exhausted the 2 attempts you will NOT meet the TEAS eligibility requirements for candidacy.

- **Students considering the following programs will need to achieve an **OVERALL Proficient level score (58.7-77.3%)** on the TEAS exam.**

In addition in each of the four (4) sections (English, Reading, Science & Math) students need to achieve:

58.7% | Registered Nursing Program (RN)

58.7% | LPN to RN Advanced Standing Pathway (LPN to RN)

50% | Licensed Practical Nursing (LPN)

- **ATI offers "ATI Remote Proctor – Nursing" multiple times per day, 6 days per week**
- **Cost of the TEAS is \$115** which will be paid via credit, debit, pre-paid card, on-line prior to taking the exam



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- Registration for ATI TEAS EXAM is done online

Official TEAS Transcripts:

Testing via TEAS at ATI, you will receive one complimentary transcript with your registration. Choose the school in which to submit this official transcript. You may send the transcript following the completion of your TEAS exam by logging into your student account at www.atitesting.com/login [atitesting.com] and selecting **SEND TRANSCRIPT** under **TEAS ACTIVITY** or by selecting the **MY RESULTS** tab and clicking **SEND TRANSCRIPT** below your scored proctored TEAS exam results.

ATI is partnering with Proctorio to virtually proctor exams.

Proctorio is a remote proctoring platform that uses machine learning to proctor students from wherever they may be. Each student will go through a system diagnostic test and test taker verification prior to taking an assessment, which will require the following:

- Webcam
- Audio
- Internet connection
- Desktop screen share
- E-Signature
- Student or government-issued ID
- Install Google chrome
