# CHOOSING COURSES 101



Choose courses that count toward your associate degree and your bachelor's degree at the same time

## Before you register, take 20 min to research courses:

- Review the <u>degree map</u> for your major to see which courses you need to graduate. TIP: Footnotes contain information about which specific courses to take.
- Learn which classes fulfill the <u>Pathways Common Core.</u> TIP: Read <u>Pathways to Your Bachelor's</u> on Blackboard
- Research <u>Articulation Agreements</u>, which help you choose courses that will count towards your major at your four-year school. TIP: Read <u>About Articulation Agreements</u> on Blackboard
- → Visit **DegreeWorks** and write down which courses you still need to take.

#### Before finalizing course selections, verify your choices:

- Use the Degree Calculator in the LaGuardia mobile app to make sure you're on track to graduate.
- Meet with an advisor to review your course selections and avoid costly mistakes. Not every course is offered every semester, so taking courses in the wrong sequence will delay graduation and transfer.
