Thinking about withdrawing from a course? Read this first, and then talk to your professor and advisor.



Important: If you get *any* of these grades for a required course, you'll have to **retake that course.** This could mean you'll be in school longer, pay more, and delay transfer. Plus, Ws on your transcript may be a **red flag** to some four-year schools.
