Create

Create your ePortfolio using the template in your First Year Seminar. As you move along their degree maps, keep adding sections that represent your college experience inside and outside of the classroom.



Edit and Publish

You can add text, images, colors, and content that reflect who you are as a student and who you aspire to be in your future career. When working on any section, publish changes to capture your ideas.



Update

We encourage you to work with the same ePortfolio every semester, add coursework, co-curricular experiences, and other content. Sustained engagement will result in a robust ePortfolio when you graduate which can be shared with others



Share

Review the privacy settings and share your ePortfolio with classmates in your course, your professor and advisor, and others you want to see your work. Sharing an ePortfolio with the appropriate audiences is a goal.
