Key Courses

- **English Composition I (ENG101)***
- **Mathematics of Medical Dosages (MAT106)*
or Medical Dosage Calculation with Pre-Algebra (MAT 105)***
- **Human Anatomy and Physiology I (SCB203)***
- **General Psychology (SSY101)***

***Key courses** must be completed before the end of **Session I** of the semester in which you are applying for candidacy.

Note:

Transferring Science courses SCB203 & SCB204 are valid for 7 years only.

Admission into the clinical phase is very competitive; **100** top students are accepted each semester based on a GPA ranking system.

Additional Program Requirements

- **First Year Seminar for Health Sciences (HSF 90)****
- **Human Anatomy and Physiology II (SCB204)****

****Must be completed before the end of Session II** of the semester in which you are applying for candidacy.

Take Your TEAS Exam

- Must be taken through ATI's Remote Proctoring: dates and information are available on the Licensed Practical Nurse Program's Website
- The ATI TEAS Exam must be taken remotely by ATI; in-person exam results will NOT be accepted.
- ATI TEAS results must be submitted to HealthSci@lagcc.cuny.edu by **May 5, 2025**.
- Must achieve a minimum score of 50% on each of four exam sections
- Must achieve overall score in the Proficient Level (58.7%)
- Students **only** have 2 attempts to take the TEAS Exam for the Licensed Practical Nurse Program.

When/Where to apply for candidacy

- **Candidacy Application available in Spring Session I only.**
- If eligible, apply for candidacy by **April 21, 2025**
- Obtain and submit Candidacy Form to the Health Sciences Department: HealthSci@lagcc.cuny.edu
- Application code is LPN 000
