I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Chair Bruns at 2:23pm.

IV. Vote on Curriculum Committee Consent Calendar Item from February 8, 2024. A motion to approve the curriculum committee consent calendar items from February 8, 2024 was made by Senator Pappas. Senator Buckley seconded the motion. Vote: Aye-26, Nay-0, Abstain-0. The curriculum consent calendar was approved.

V. Vote on Academic Year 2024-2025 Calendar.

Chair Bruns shared that the academic year 2024-2025 calendar has been amended. The vote is being postponed until next week, which is after the Academic Standing Committee meets. We will hold an electronic vote.

VI. Vote on Online Learning Policy

Caterina Almendral, Chair of the Academic Standing Committee presented a new Online Learning Policy that states minimum requirements for students enrolling in each learning modality. Senator Correa moved to approve the proposed Online Learning policy. This was seconded by Senator Isaacs. The Senate voted unanimously to approve the policy in a voice vote.

VII. Election to fill vacancy in Senate's Executive Committee

Senator DiCarolo is stepping down from an at-large seat on the Executive Committee. Chair Bruns urged Faculty Senators to step-up on the work of Senate, while noting the large staff participation. Patricia Sokolski noted the inequity regarding faculty and staff serving on Senate because contributions and recognition for faculty and staff are different. Chair Bruns called for nominations. Roman Senkov nominated himself. He was elected. Aye: 22, No: 0

Senator Buckley and Senator Pappas nominated themselves to serve on the committee of committees and were elected by voice vote.
