Milestone 1: Complete Career Coach

Complete a <u>career assessment</u> to see how to align your <u>major</u> with your <u>career goals</u> and transfer plan. During your first year, attend a college info session and consider:

- The majors that fit your skills and goals (<u>Want to</u> <u>change your major?</u>).
- Attending a four-year college or scholarship event.
- Checking out the **<u>full guide</u>** to transferring.

We recommend completing <u>1 Transfer and 1-2 Career</u> <u>Milestones</u> each semester.

Milestone 3: Submit Personal Statement

It's time to narrow down your search. Organize:

- **<u>Personal statements</u>** and recommendation letters.

- Plan your credit transfer using the <u>What-if Tool</u>, <u>CUNY Explorer</u>, and <u>SUNY Course tables</u>

Milestone 4: Complete Exit Interview

Exit Interviews are conducted with Advisor during your last semester.

To complete the application process:

Keep track of your deadlines.
Clear any holds on your account.
Request transcripts, including high school transcript if necessary.
Review your essays with the Writing Center.
Follow up on recommendation letters a week before the deadlines.
