CUNY's Cap and Gown Survey

- The Cap and Gown Graduation Survey is administered centrally by CUNY and appears on the To Do list for graduates and pending graduates in CUNYfirst.
- The survey includes questions about the graduates' college experience, post-degree employment and future educational pursuits. Responses are voluntary.
- The results presented here are for 2022-23 (Summer 2022, Fall 2022, and Spring 2023). This is the first year for which data from the full graduation year are available.
- The results are separated for AAS and AA/As graduates from LaGuardia, but not for the other CUNY community colleges.

Response Rates

- ► The overall response rates for the community colleges is 29%
- Individual colleges response rates ranged from over 35% for Bronx and Guttman, to 24% for Queensborough. At 27% LaGuardia's response rate is at the lower range compared to the other community colleges

Community Colleges Response rates

Employment - LaGuardia and CUNY Community Colleges

- Overall, 59% of LaGuardia's graduates are or will be employed. The proportion is similar for AAS and AA/AS graduates, although fewer of the AAS graduates indicated that they are not seeking employment (5% vs.12%). With the exception of Hostos (71%), this proportion is similar to most of CUNY's community colleges.
- Overall, close to half of all graduates reported that their job is not related to their major while at CUNY; However, only 39% of the LaGuardia AAS graduates selected this option.


Employment Information

- Overall, 57% of LaGuardia students worked full-time (more than 35 hours) -61% of AAS compared with 57% of the AA/AS graduates. The overall proportion is similar to all community colleges, ranging form 52% for BMCC graduates to 62% for KCC graduates.
- Thirds of all LaGuardia graduates earned less than \$30,000, a slightly lower proportion compared to the other community colleges. Notably, 10% of the AAS LaGuardia graduates earn \$10,000 or more compared with 3% overall.

LaGuardia Graduates - job location and degree requirement

- Location: The jobs of most graduates were located in Queens (51% AAS, 39% AA/AS) and Manhattan (27% AAS, 32% AA/AS).
- There is a considerable difference in jobs' degree requirements for AAS, compared to AA/AS, graduates. Associate degree was required for 43% of the jobs of AAS graduates compared to 16% for the AS/AS. Moreover, 61% of the AA/AS graduates' jobs did NOT require a degree, compared to 39% of the AAS jobs.

Sales and related occupations, followed by Education and Library, Healthcare Support and Food Preparation were the occupations more frequently mentioned by the AA/AS graduates.

For AAS graduates, the occupations most frequently mentioned were Healthcare Practitioners (15%), followed by Healthcare Support & Computer and Mathematical occupations 13% for both), and Food Preparation & Legal jobs (11% for both).

Additional Education

- Over half of the CUNY community college graduates currently pursue additional education - with the highest proportions at Hostos (60%), followed by LaGuardia (57% - AAS 54%, AA/AS 58%), and the lowest in the Bronx and BMCC (46-47%). Additional 30% - 40% plan on pursuing additional education in the future.
- The vast majority of students plan on attending CUNY for additional education.

Experiential Learning and Internships

- Considerably more LaGuardia students had internships (paid and overall), especially the AAS graduates compared to graduates at the other community colleges.
- Approximately two-thirds of community college graduates, Including the AA/AS LaGuardia graduates did not participate in any experiential learning activities. However, due to their sizable internship participation, only 47% on the AAS graduates did not participate.

Professional Opportunities

- Only about 40% of CUNY's community college graduates have a LinkedIn profile. At LaGuardia, the proportion is higher, with 52% of all graduates and 59% of AAS graduates indicating they have an up-to-date LinkedIn profile.
- The most utilized source of information used by over half of all community college graduates - is job search websites. However, at LaGuardia, AAS graduates are using it at considerably higher rates compared to AA/As graduates (56% vs.47%), while LinkedIn is the most utilized source (50%). Similarly, *Peers, friends or family* is the 2nd most utilized resource overall and for AAS LaGuardia graduates but not LaGuardia's AA/AS.
