
LaGCC Student Conduct Flow Chart



Please Note

- 1. Investigation: (Article 15, section 15.4) 'The preliminary investigation shall be concluded within thirty (30) calendar days of the filing of the complaint, unless: (i) said complaint involves two or more complainants or respondents; or (ii) said complaint involves a matter that is also under investigation by law enforcement authorities. 2. In those cases, the preliminary investigation shall be completed within sixty (60) calendar days.'
- Respondent no longer at the institution: (Article 15, section 15.4d) In the event that a respondent withdraws from the college after a charge, accusation or allegation against a respondent has been made, and the college prefers formal disciplinary charges, the respondent is required to participate in the disciplinary hearing or otherwise to resolve the pending charges and shall be barred from attending any other unit of the university until a decision on the charges is made or the charges are otherwise resolved
- Emergency Suspension: (Article 15, section 15.4j) The president or her/his designee may in emergency or extraordinary circumstances, temporarily suspend a student pending an early hearing as provided in this bylaw section.
- if the issue is resolved prior to the process, please notify the VP of student affairs and the process will be halted.
