

# CANDIDACY INFORMATION SHEET VETERINARY TECHNOLOGY

### **Key Courses**

- English Composition I (ENG101)\*
- College Algebra & Trigonometry (MAT115) or Algebra and Trigonometry (MAT 117)\*
- Vertebrate Anatomy and Physiology I (SCB208)\*
- Foundations of Chemistry (SCC110) OR General Chemistry (SCC201): prerequisite of MAT 115 in prior session/semester is required.)\*

#### **Additional Program Requirements**

• First Year Seminar for Health Sciences (HSF 90)\*\*

\*Key courses must be completed before the end of Session I of the semester in which you are applying for candidacy.

**Note:** Transferring science course SCC110 is valid for 10 years only.

Admission into the clinical phase is very competitive; top students are accepted each semester based on a GPA ranking system.

**\*\***Must be completed before the end of **Session II** of the semester in which you are applying for candidacy.

#### **Volunteer/Work Experience**

- A minimum of 40 hours of volunteer or work experience in a veterinary setting is required for acceptance to the clinical phase of the program.
- Documentation of Volunteer/Work experience is required by December 31st in the year which the student is applying for candidacy.

## When/Where to apply for candidacy

- Candidacy Application available in Fall I only.
- If eligible, apply for candidacy by the Fall candidacy deadline: October 18, 2024
- Obtain and submit Candidacy Form to the Health Sciences Department: HealthSci@lagcc.cuny.edu
- Application code is VTA 000
