- 1. **Meeting Minutes Approval:** The Committee approved the February 10, 2025, meeting minutes with revisions.
- 2. **Proposed FYS Policy:** The Director of First Year Programming answered Committee questions about the proposed policy. The Committee is still considering the policy. Current discussion centers upon how Change of Majors should be included in the policy, formatting, and clarification of language (e.g., long session being changed to Session I and short session being changed to Session II). Transfer students are required to take FYS even if they have taken it in other schools.
- 3. **Proposed Emergency Distance Learning Policy**: The Committee is still considering the policy and following up with relevant Senate Committees.
- 4. Repeat Course Policy:
  - a. The Academic Standing Committee (ASC) was notified of a disconnect between the intention of the Repeat Course Policy revisions approved by the Senate in May 2022 and the interpretation of the policy in the implementation. The ASC has been working closely with the Senate and Registrar to ensure this is addressed.
  - b. The ASC discussed policy clarifications that would ensure the policy is clearly interpreted going forward. Clarification updates were approved but then held back from moving forward based upon feedback indicating further clarification is needed.
  - c. The ASC continues to discuss considerations raised regarding Transfer students.
