- **English Composition I** (ENG 101)*
- **General Psychology** (SSY 101)*
- **Human Anatomy & Physiology I** (SCB 203)*
- **Math Requirement:**
- **one of the following courses**
 - College Algebra and Trigonometry** (MAT 115)*
 - or Algebra and Trigonometry** (MAT 117)*
 - or Elementary Statistics I** (MAT 120)*
 - or Statistics with Elementary Algebra** (MAT 119)*

***Key courses** must be completed before the end of **Session I** of the semester in which you are applying for candidacy.

Note:

Transferring Science courses SCB203 & SCB204 are valid for 7 years only.

Admission into the clinical phase is very competitive; top students are accepted each semester based on a GPA ranking system.

TEAS Exam is Not Required

- This program no longer requires ATI TEAS Exam; effective Spring 2023 semester.

Additional Program Requirements

- First Year Seminar for Health Sciences (HSF 90) must be completed before the end of session II of semester of candidacy application.
- All pre-clinical courses **MUST** be completed before the start of technical courses. Failure to complete all ten (10) courses before start of the program will forfeit the PTA Candidacy.
- Students **MUST** meet with PTA Faculty in person to obtain a candidacy application. Request an appointment at HealthSci@lagcc.cuny.edu.

When/Where to apply for candidacy

- Candidacy Application available Fall I (Clinical phase in Spring II) or Spring I (Clinical phase in Fall II).
- If eligible, apply for candidacy by the Fall Deadline October 17, 2025.
- Obtain and submit Candidacy Form to the Health Sciences Department: HealthSci@lagcc.cuny.edu
- Application code is PTA 000

Note: Successful candidates are scheduled to begin the Clinical Phase in session II of the following semester.
